## FOSTER GARDEN

Built in 1999 / 2000, the Foster garden was created around an existing cherry tree (Prunus Kanzan) in the center of the garden. In one just single and bold gesture Roberto Silva designed the garden using a slate wall that frames and undulates the entire space. The result is a garden with three different areas: A path made of self-binding gravel and patio under the tree, the lawn and the round decking on the far end of the garden where the owners entertain their friends and clients. It is a dynamic garden in which the cherry tree creates different moods throughout the seasons dropping its pink petals and golden leaves on the abstract shapes of the garden.
